WHAT IS EIA?


"systematic process to identify potential positive and negative impacts on the environment associated with a proposed activity/development"







WHAT IS EIA...




Objective

- Identify likely environmental, social and economic impacts of an activity
- Inform and facilitate integrated decision-making
 - Allow/disallow
 - Mitigation measures (conditions)





STRATEGIC EIA (SEA)




objective
