

Recent Survey on State of Environmental Law Teaching in Asia



LIC university of cebu

- 39 Surveys from 14 countries: Bangladesh, Cambodia, India, Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, Nepal, Pakistan, Peoples' Republic of China, Philippines, Sri Lanka, Thailand & Viet Nam
- Universities with faculty of law in these countries range from 8 to 600 (Cambodia 8 and PRC 600)
- Teaching of Enviro Law Compulsory in Basic Law Degrees in India, Indonesia and Philippines
- Over 50% of all law schools teach environmental law subjects in a basic law degree program even though not compulsory by regulatory bodies in education













Why teaching of enviro law is still challenging?

- Lack of professors or lecturers
- Lack of support & understanding




