PROMULGATE

The law on the establishment of the Ministry of Environment has been approved by the 5th session of the first legislature of the National Assembly. The whole context is as follows:

LAW ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE MINISTRY OF ENVIRONMENT

- Article 1: The Ministry of Environment is established under the jurisdiction of the Royal Government of Cambodia.
- Article 2: The Ministry of Environment has the competence of leading and administering the domain of Environment of the Kingdom of Cambodia.
- Article 3: The Ministry of Environment is headed by a Minister and assisted by a Secretary of State and /or Under Secretary of State according to the necessity.
- Article 4: The organization and the functioning of the Ministry of Environment shall be delineated by the Sub-Decree.
- Article 5: Any dispositions contrast to this Law shall be abrogated.
- Article 6: This Law shall be announced immediately.
