SUB-DECREE No.47 ON THE CREATION OF THE NATIONAL CLEAN ENVIRONMENT DAY

Phnom Penh, June 12, 1995

Seen the Constitution of the Kingdom of Cambodia; Seen the Royal Decree of His majesty the King of Cambodia Samdech Preach Norodom Sihanouk Varman dated November 01, 1993 on the Appointment of the Royal Government; Seen the Law on the Organisation and Functioning of the Council of Ministers promulgated by the Royal Decree No.02/94 dated July 20, 1994; and Pursuant to the proposal of the Ministry of Environment;

It is Hereby Decided

Article 1:

To create a Day to encourage people to participate through their labor in the cleaning of municipalities, public gathering places, residences in the countryside, Buddhist monasteries, schools, hospitals, factories, market places and commercial centers with the aim of keeping and increasing the quality of the environment of the Nation. Such Day shall be called "The National Clean Environment Day" and shall be held on November 23 of every year.

Article 2:

The objective of The National Clean Environment Day is to encourage all citizen, military service men, police officers, civil-servants of all ranks, pupils and students of all schools to devote all their efforts to such tasks in order to eliminate the pollution to the environment.

Article 3:

Civilians of both sexes, monks, military service men, police officers, civil-servants of all ranks, pupils and students shall be obligated to participate through their labor by cleaning gardens and parks to celebrate the National Clean Environment Day on November 23.

Article 4:

The Ministry of Interior shall have the duty to instruct governors of provinces and municipalities about this matter and to specify places to be cleaned.

Article 5:

The Ministry of Environment shall have the roles and responsibilities to instruct on technical issue and to co-operate with the Commission for the National Day Celebration and provincial and municipality institutions in implementing this Sub-Decree and shall submit such report to the Council of Ministers.

Article 6:

The Co-Ministers in charge of the Office of the Council of Ministers, the Commission for National Day Celebration, ministers, State secretaries and Governors of provinces and municipalities shall implement this sub-Decree within their respective capacity from the date of its signatures.
