Appeal.--(1) Orders passed by a superior Court in case of contempt shall be appealable in the following manner:--

(i) in the case of an order passed by a single Judge of a High Court an Intra-Court Appeal shall lie to a Bench of two or more Judges;

(ii) in a case in which the original order has been passed by a division or larger Bench of a High Court an appeal as of right shall lie to the Supreme Court; and

(iii) in the case of an original order passed by a bench of the Supreme Court an Intra-Court Appeal shall lie to a larger Bench of the Court.

(2) The appellate Court may suspend the impugned order pending disposal of the appeal.

(3) The period of filing an appeal shall be thirty days.

Ordinance to be exhaustive.--Save as, and to the extent expressly provided in this Ordinance, no Act or statement of any person shall constitute contempt of Court or be punishable therefor.

23. Repeal.--The Contempt of Court Act, 1976 (LXIV of 1976) is hereby repealed.

PAKISTAN FISH INSPECTION AND QUALITY CONTROL (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1998

An Ordinance to amend the Pakistan Fish Inspection and Quality Control Act, 1997

[Gazette of Pakistan, Extraordinary, Part I,
29th October, 1998]

No. F.2(1)/98-Pub., dated 29-10-1998.--The following Ordinance made by the President is hereby published for general information:--

Whereas, it is expedient to amend the Pakistan Fish Inspection and Quality Control Act, 1997 (XXXV of 1997), for the purposes hereinafter appearing;

And whereas the National Assembly is not in session and the President is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate

Now, therefore, in exercise of the power conferred by clause (1) of

Article 89 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, the President is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:--

1. **Short title and commencement.**--(1) This Ordinance may be called the Pakistan Fish Inspection and Quality Control (Amendment) Ordinance, 1998.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. **Amendment of section 5, Act XXXV of 1997.**--In the Pakistan Fish Inspection and Quality Control Act, 1997 (XXXV of 1997), hereinafter referred to as the said Act, in section 5, in subsection (1), the words "and a broad based trade association of fish processing plants", at the end, shall be omitted.

3. **Amendment of section 12, Act XXXV of 1997.**--In the said Act, in section 12, in subsection (1), for clauses (i) to (iv) the following shall be substituted, namely:--

"(i) on a first conviction with fine which may extend to one hundred thousand rupees;

(ii) on a second conviction with fine which may extend to two hundred thousand rupees; and

(iii) for any subsequent conviction with imprisonment for a term which may extend to one year, or with fine which may extend to five hundred thousand rupees, or with both."
