Let a Rule Nisi be issued, calling upon the respondents to show cause as to why a direction should not be given upon the respondents not to set-up 1300 MW Khulna Coal Based Thermal Power Station Mouza Sapmari-Katakhali No. 09 and Koigordaskathi No. 10 of Rampal Upzilla, District-Bagerhat to protect Eco System and Environment of the locality as well as the world largest Mangrove Forest "Sundarban" and protect the Highly fertile arable land and protect health of the dwellers of the adjacent cites and why a direction should not be given upon the

respondents not to cut/destroy tress situated in Mouza Sapmari-Katakhali No. 09 and Koigordaskathi No. 10 of Rampal Upzilla, District-Bagerhat not to take any step against environment of the locality and/or why such other or further order or orders, as the this court may deem fit and proper, should not be passed.

Pending hearing of the Rule, the parties are directed to maintain **Status-Quo** in respect of implementation of the Project of 1300 MW Khulna Coal Based Thermal Power Station Mouza Sapmari-Katakhali No. 09 and Koigordaskathi No. 10 of Rampal Upzilla, District-Bagerhat to till 3rd April 2011 from date.

The rule is made returnable within 2(Two) weeks from date.

The petitioner is directed to put in the requisites for service of notice upon the respondent in usual course and through registered post.

Let this matter come up in the list for hearing on 3rd April 2011, as prayed for.
